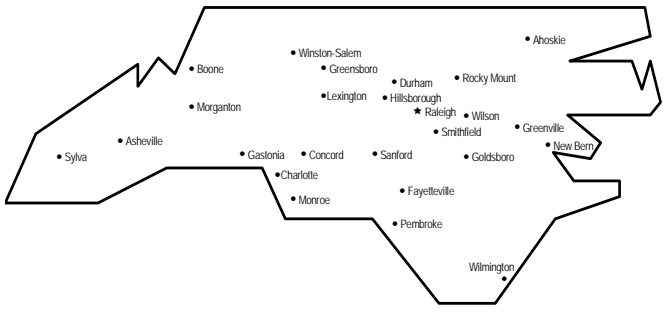

WHAT WE CAN HELP YOU DO!

Legal Aid of North Carolina can help you with the following **Medicare Part D** problems:

1) Coverage of a medication prescribed by your doctor.

If your doctor has prescribed a specific medication that you need, your prescription drug plan may tell you that they won’t cover the drug. We can help you file a request for an “exception” (an appeal) with the drug plan. We can also represent you at a Medicare administrative hearing if the drug plan does not resolve your issue.

2) Denials by the Social Security Administration for “Extra Help” to pay your Medicare Part D premium and co-pays.

If you are low-income, you may be eligible for a subsidy (also called “Extra Help”) to help you pay for your Medicare Part D premiums and co-pays. If you have applied for extra help and have been denied, Legal Aid of North Carolina can help you with an appeal to the Social Security Administration.

WHAT WE CAN HELP YOU DO!

3) Proper Enrollment for Medicare Part D when you are having problems.

If you have problems related to enrollment in a particular drug plan or are being assessed penalties for late enrollment that was not your fault, we can help you to straighten out problems related to your enrollment.
